KEEP IT CLEAN!

Ear, Face and Body

All procedures are carried out using pre autoclaved or disposable utensils in a clean environment.

The difficult job of keeping it clean is now your responsibility!

BEFORE YOU CLEAN YOUR NEW PIERCING ALWAYS WASH YOUR HANDS...

This is singularly the best way to avoid spreading bacteria

There may be some redness, tenderness and swelling around the piercing site and you will experience some clear discharge called lymph fluid. These are all part of the healing process.

Should your piercing become *excessively* red, swollen, painful or have an odorous yellow or greenish discharge either return to the studio or see your doctor.

- ◆ Put a few drops of the solution provided by your piercer onto a cotton bud. Clean all round one side of your piercing removing any crusty matter that may be stuck to the jewellery. Using the other end of the bud, repeat the procedure on the other side of your piercing. With a clean cotton bud, dry each side. Do not re-use cotton buds for multiple piercings.
- ◆ When showering, use a pea sized amount of antibacterial soap. Lather between your hands and use to wash your piercing. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly with clean kitchen towel. Avoid using bath towels; they harbour bacteria & leave small fibres which can irritate your piercing.
- ◆ Do not use inside your mouth

AND LASTLY... LEAVE IT ALONE!
